In my language (Slovak), we have this accented character: l' (in TeX, that would be $v\{l\}$, not $'\{l\}$, which is a different letter - l)

- keyboard shortcut A-V l should produce $l^\prime,$ what it does is $\check{\ }l$ instead
- when importing from TeX, the character imports as Ĭ, which is typographically wrong
- when importing from a (unicode) html, the character gets imported correctly as I'
