

Chapter 1

In Which we Attempt a List in a Figure

I am trying to create a floating figure that contains a list in which the items may span several lines, but am having trouble because when I try this the items don't "wrap". This is with TeXmacs 1.0.7.3 running on Ubuntu 10.04.

Here, I create the figure \rightarrow \leftarrow , known as Figure 1.1. Note the problem reading all of Step 3.

- 1a.** Create a figure with Insert->Page Insertion->Floating figure
- 1b.** Label and caption the figure, just because I always do that
- 2a.** Create the list with the "Aligned" style
- 2b.** Other styles may demonstrate the problem; I've not checked
- 2c.** I'm using aligned because I happen to want slightly strange numbering
 - 3.** Enter some really really long text, to demonstrate that it goes off into the margin rather than wrapping each line as I wanted it to.
 - 4.** Create a simplified copy just giving these instructions, to verify the problem
 - 5.** Get help from TeXmacs-users mailing list.

Here is a copy of the content of the figure, which line-wraps just fine:

- 1a.** Create a figure with Insert->Page Insertion->Floating figure
- 1b.** Label and caption the figure, just because I always do that

- 2c.** I'm using aligned because I happen to want slightly strange numbering
